

## Autumn Welcome

### Supply List:

1 fat quarter of background  
4" x 18" piece of brown for "floor"  
Various green scraps for leaves, approximately 1/8 yard total  
Various orange scraps for pumpkins, approximately 5/8 yard total, the more variety the better  
Scrap of brown fabric, ~1" square will work  
1/8 yard black solid fabric  
1 fat quarter brown for binding (not needed during class)

For fusible method, you will also need:

Embroidery floss for embellishment in the color(s) of your choice (you can use all black, all brown, or match the colors to your fabrics, if you wish) You will need 2 skeins of brown for the added embroidery embellishment as well.

2 yards of fusible webbing (I use Heat 'n' Bond Lite)

For needle-turn method, you will also need:

Thread to match the fabrics you've chosen for your applique: green, orange, brown, black.

Scissors for fabric

Scissors for paper

Embroidery needles

Your favorite thimble

Marking pencil (a lead pencil is fine, even a Sharpie fine-point will work for this)

Fabric marking pencil for light fabrics

Fabric marking pencil for dark fabrics

To prepare before class:

Make sure your fat quarter of background fabric is straight, and sew the strip of brown "floor" fabric to one short side of the background fabric to act as the base for the applique, as shown. Press the seam toward the darker fabric.
