



POMEGRANATES & PINEAPPLES

18" x 38"

This table runner has a very simple pieced center, with appliqued borders on both sides. Done in dark colors, it's very fitting for a fall table setting. With pineapples representing hospitality, and pomegranates representing love, you'll be setting a very welcome table indeed.

Materials needed

For the pieced center, and the applique, you'll need: Assorted scraps to equal 3/4 yard, the more variety, the better. You could use a charm pack of 5" squares for part of it. Choose dark reds, olive greens, browns, blacks, and throw in some lighter tans or beiges for some good contrast.

For the vines and leaves, you'll need 1 fat quarter of green, or you could use a variety of different greens.

For the applique background (side borders) and binding, you'll need 1 yard of a black print.

5/8 yd. for backing

24" x 44" piece of batting

If you'll be doing fusible applique, you will also need 1 yard of fusible webbing.

To prepare your background before class begins, cut from your applique background fabric:

2 strips 6-1/2" x WOF (width of fabric)
