

Supply List for Needle-Turn Applique Class

Basic hand sewing supplies (needles, thimble, etc.)

Basic sewing supplies (pins/pincushion, seam ripper, snippers, etc.)

Fabric scissors

Paper scissors

Thread:

When doing hand applique, you should use thread that matches the fabric you'll be appliqueing down, not the background fabric, so choose a few colors that coordinate with your applique fabrics and bring those. I will also bring some of mine that you can use out of to give a bigger variety of colors, so if you can't find exactly what you need, don't worry. We'll discuss more about thread in class.

Needles:

Bring hand sewing needles that you feel comfortable with. There are needles especially for applique, but some people find them difficult to thread. I will bring some different kinds and sizes for you to experiment with as well.

In class, we will be learning how to do the needle-turn method of hand applique. The project is designed to teach you all the basics of certain shapes, so you can apply these techniques to other applique projects in the future. You will most likely not get a completed project finished during class, but you will go away with the knowledge of how to finish your project after class.

If you would prefer learning how to do the fusible method of applique instead, we can cover that, too. Be sure to bring some fusible webbing, and if you want to hand stitch your edges, bring some embroidery floss in a color you'd like to use.

The pattern for the project will be provided in class, so you will have all the finishing instructions when you leave.

Be sure to do the preparation work outlined in your supply list for the project you've chosen before you come to Camp.
