



# Wild Carnations

12" x 44"

This table runner is shown in two different colorways, but feel free to come up with your own version using your own favorite colors.

## Fabric requirements:

All yardages are based on 44" wide fabric. Good quality, 100% cotton fabrics are recommended.

## For the background:

An assortment of reds or beiges to equal 3/4 yard. The more variety, the better. Scraps would work really well.

## For the leaves and vines:

One fat quarter to cut bias vines from, and some of the leaves can be cut from it as well

Various green scraps to equal 1/4 yard

## For the flowers:

Light: one fat eighth

Medium: one fat quarter

Dark: one fat eighth

Centers: scraps

Binding: 1/4 yard

Backing 18" x 50" piece

Batting 18" x 50" piece

Wild Carnations are appliqued onto a pieced background. You need to have your background prepared before class begins, so use the instructions below to get your background ready, and I'll provide you with the proper templates and the rest of the instructions in class!

### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

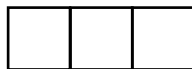
From the various background fabrics, cut:

33 4-1/2" squares

### SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

Use a 1/4" seam to join the background pieces.

To assemble the background, sew the squares into rows of three as shown below. You will end up with 11 rows.



Make 11 of these units.

Join these rows to make the background. Stitch around the edge of the background piece 1/8" from the raw edge, to keep the background stable while you do the applique and quilting.
